The following statement was agreed at NICC Security TG27, held on the 12th April 2017.

This document will be circulated to the NICC Security TG membership.

NICC Security TG statement

- The Security TG is out of abeyance around a CR to NICC ND1643 v4.1.1 from BT specifically concerning Physical Security and the requirements of the standard (coupled with ambiguous scope statements within the standard)
- The specific issue relates to 'Legacy Equipment' and the general operating model of MUAs
- The Security TG have suggested that the Exceptions process already defined within the standard may be used with the justification that the standard will be re-written (in part) by the Security TG with an, as yet unspecified, end date.
- This approach was verbally agreed with OFCOM present as part of the discussion held at Security TG26.
- The Security TG note that, at the subsequent Security TG 27, a bullet list of observations on ND1643 was made and will be discussed both at NICC TSG and with further industry representation.
- The Security TG request an explicit approval of this statement from OFCOM – ideally by the end of April.
